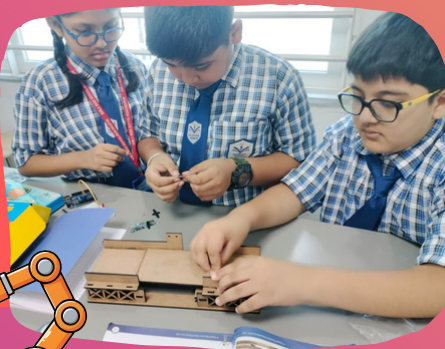
From Piggy Banks to Smart Banks
